RULES

SAFETY IS EVERYTHING- for yourself and the audience. Is everything secure on your vehicle or float? Travel at walking pace only. You must be able to stop in time without causing an injury to persons on your vehicle or to an onlooker. Children may run out of the crowd unexpectedly. Be prepared.

The Lions Club organise and hold Public Liability insurance for the Parade. By being in the Parade you agree to follow their directions.

For all entries -loud noises and exhausts may spook animals or scare the crowd. You may not be permitted to join in the Parade if your entry is too loud.

Lions Parade Marshalls can ask you to withdraw during the Parade if they regard your entry as unsafe or not in the spirit of the parade—it is a family Christmas event.

No loud or sudden noises, especially near livestock which may get spooked.

No lolly throwing, water bombing, flour bombing, or sprays.
